**Re:** Nevada Transportation Authority- Required Action

The Nevada Transportation Authority (NTA) is now requiring all drivers transporting passengers who are employed in the state of Nevada to comply with new adopted regulation

Nevada SRS AUTHORITY: §§1-7, NRS 706.171 and section 2 of Senate Bill No. 210, Chapter 402, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page 2177 (NRS 706.462).

All Greyhound Drivers based out of the state of Nevada will be required to adhere to this new state regulation. This will require drivers to go through a state mandated FBI background check to obtain a permit with the Nevada Transportation Authority.

The Company will cover the initial cost of the process. Drivers will not be paid for the time required to complete this process, nor allowed to take time off their runs, nor be compensated for any missed earnings as a result of this process. This process is required by the State in order to maintain your driving eligibility in Nevada.

Drivers will be required to complete an application, have their fingerprints processed, take passport picture, and sign a civil applicant waiver. This process will take approximately 15 minutes at the fingerprinting location. The Company will gather the above items, a copy of the drivers MVR-and submit with the processing fee to complete this process. Drivers are not expected to incur out of pocket expenses at this time.
